# Top Table and lunchtime arrangements

## Junior lunchtime sports

Mr Mason has collected the classes school council books in and is going to try and put a rota together for the different sports each year group wants with the help of the lunchtime organisers.

The plan is to try and have the new rota ready for the final week of this half term.

#### Toast

The options for toast were:

- 1. A rota which is the same each half term
- 2. A raffle where each year group starts in the pot at the start of the half term and Mr Parfitt then picks one or two out during his Friday assembly. Once a year group has been picked they then can't go back in the jar until the start of each half term to make it fair.

Each of the junior classes voted and both options got 4 votes. Mr Mason is waiting for the results from the infant classes to see if there is a winning option.

#### **Eid Parties**

- Each year will have a 30 minute slot in the hall or dining room to play party games and then can have fun activities in their classroom for the rest of the afternoon or watch a film

- It will look a little bit different this year due to the Coronavirus so there might not be as many activities or games
