The Leaves

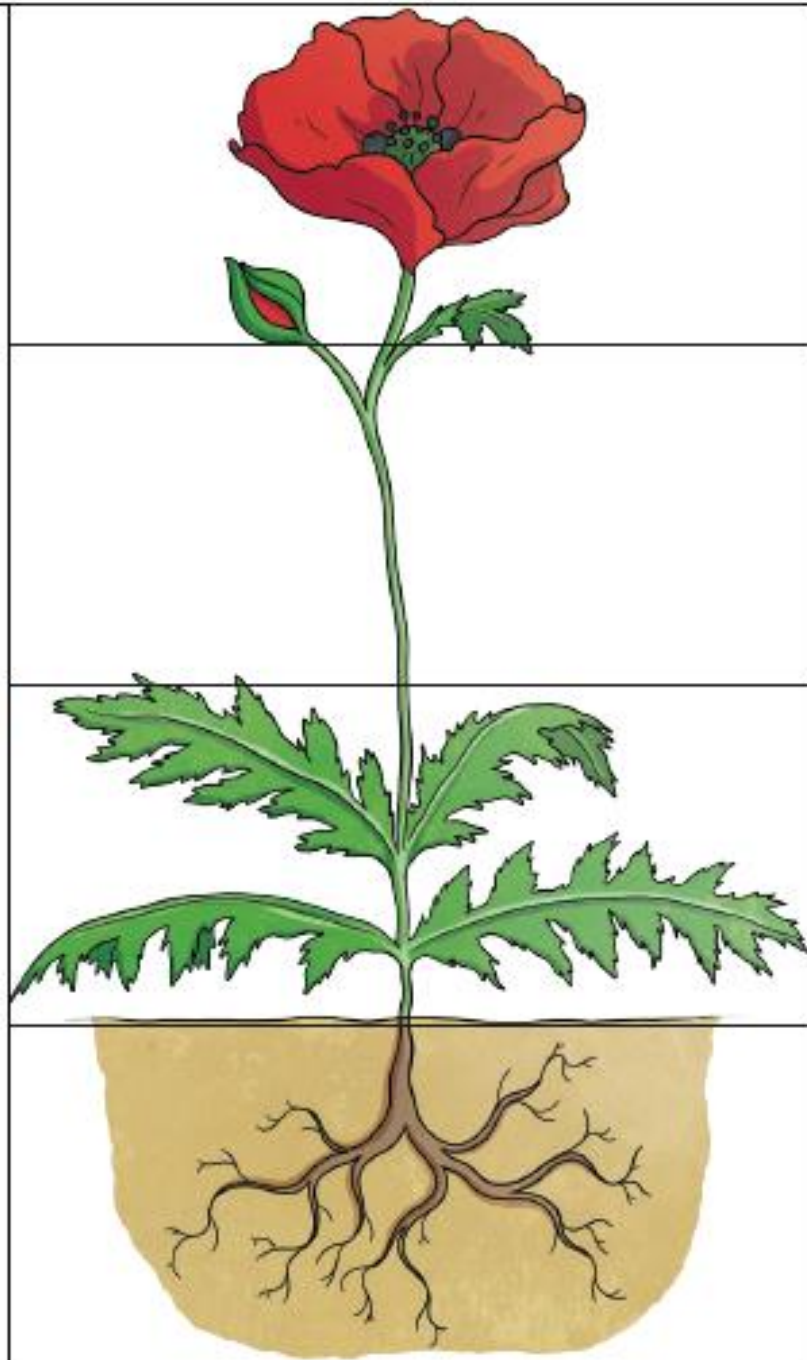
The leaves make food for the plant using sunlight and carbon dioxide from the air.

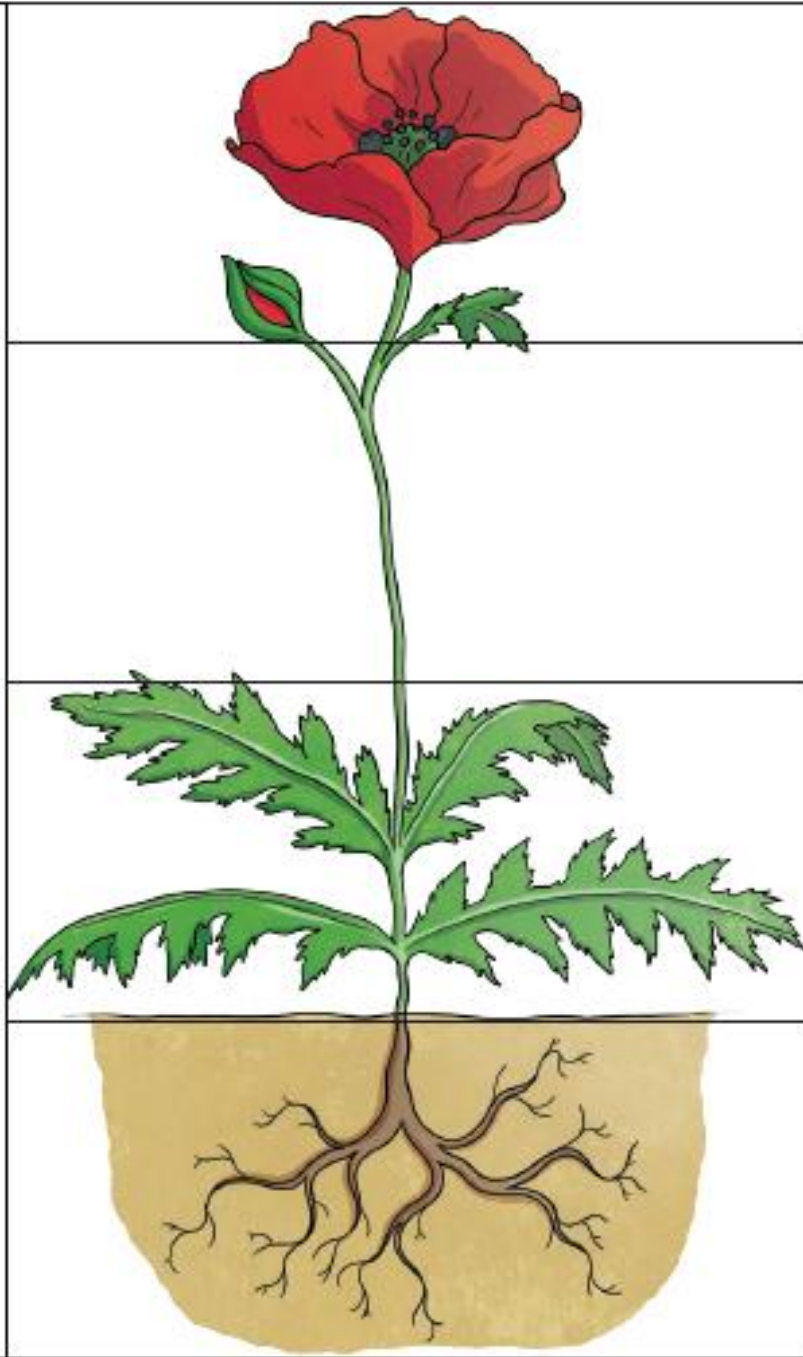
